

Certified Information Privacy Professional (CIPP/US)

Course Length: 2 days

Course Overview

U.S. Private-Sector Privacy covers U.S. privacy laws and regulations at federal and state levels, including breach notification and limits on various private sectors. You'll leave with an understanding of the legal requirements for the responsible handling and transfer of personal data within industry and workplaces, including government access to private-sector data. The training is based on the body of knowledge for the IAPP's ANSI-accredited Certified Information Privacy Professional/ U.S. (CIPP/US) certification program.

Who Should Attend

This training is a robust, interactive opportunity to learn about critical privacy concepts that are also integral to the CIPP/US exam. While not purely a "test prep" course, this training is appropriate for professionals who plan to certify, as well for those who want to deepen their privacy knowledge. Both the training and the exam are based on the same body of knowledge.
